### **Camping/ Show Rules**

Please abide by the camping rules as set out below to ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable show experience.

- \* Minimal noise late pm.
- \* All competitors to read and sign indemnity form.
- \* All riders and handlers are to be wearing the proper attire, i.e. Hard hats with harness, boots with a heel.
- \* No dogs allowed on grounds.
- \* No tethering of ponies / horses.
- \* Anything you notice that could present a problem to anyone anywhere on the premises should be reported to the event organisers.
- \* All competitors are to be drug free i.e. from being intoxicated or under the influences of drugs.
- \* Any exhibitors horse that is behaving in a dangerous manner may be asked to leave the event including, led and driven.
- \* Ponies and horses are to be ridden in specified areas only.
- \* Ponies and horses are to be ridden in bridles and not halters and must have a saddle.
- \* Only horses and ponies competing are to enter the show ring arena area.
- \* Make sure your horses and ponies are tied correctly to floats and trucks when left unattended.
- \* All litter to be placed in the bins provided leaving parking/ camping and stables areas clean.
- \* Please obey all signs and SPSOA rules placed around the grounds. The Committee wishes all an enjoyable and safe Super Show.

#### Class Rules.

- \* Brood Mare [ dry]: A mare who has had a foal registered with the APSBS during the last 3 years, or who is currently in foal.
  - \* Brood Mare [ wet ] Must have a foal at foot.
  - \* Harness Turnout: Must be owned by the one exhibitor.
  - \* Novice: Who has Not won a first place at any show.
  - \* Child Age: literally calculated appropriate to their actual birth date.
  - \* Stallion/ Colts not permitted in child handler classes.
- \* All competitors and handlers must be correctly attired before entering the ring.
  - \* The use of a groom is permitted in the ring for harness classes.

# Marshalling for Events.

\* It is the Exhibitors responsibility to ensure they are at the Marshalling area at least 5mins prior to each class.

- \* Stables must be vacated on / by Monday.

#### <u>Stables — Bedding & Cleaning.</u>

There is a cleaning deposit required for each stable. The cheque should be made payable to the Shetland Pony Society for the number of stables required. Once the Bathurst Show Trust has inspected the stables they will decide if a refund is forthcoming. If that is the case it will be posted to the exhibitors if they have the left the grounds before inspection has taken place. It there is a problem with the stables there will be no refund and the cheque will be banked. Stable Deposit will be given back after showground trust approval.

Please ensure your order for shavings is the amount needed as there will be **NO** stock kept on the grounds.

#### Wash Bays.

There are 3 wash bays available on the showground. These are located at the end of stable complex [G]. No hoses will be provided.

Please consider all exhibitors when utilising this shared facility.

### **Warm Up Areas**

- \* Warm up areas are available near the camping area, in the designated area behind the announcers box and in the round yard and is for use of all exhibitors. Please consider other when using these areas.
- \* All safety equipment must be worn when exercising ponies.
- \* All ponies must be appropriately saddled / harnessed and bitted when being exercised.
- \* Inappropriate or excessive use of whips or spurs when working ponies will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

Saturday 29th October - 7am—12 midday.


# **Dutch Auction 29th of October 2016.**
